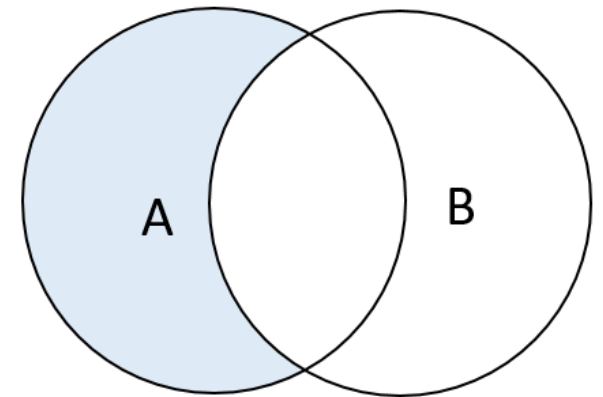


EXCEPT

EXCEPT operator is used to return all rows in the first SELECT statement that are not returned by the second SELECT statement.

Syntax

```
SELECT expression1, expression2, ...  
FROM tables  
[WHERE conditions]  
EXCEPT  
SELECT expression1, expression2, ...  
FROM tables  
[WHERE conditions];
```



EXCEPT

EXCEPT operator is used to return all rows in the first SELECT statement that are not returned by the second SELECT statement.

Example

```
SELECT customer_id  
FROM sales_2015  
EXCEPT  
SELECT customer_id  
FROM customer_20_60  
ORDER BY customer_id;
```
